_____ Tabis or covered shoes that will get wet and muddy & a plastic bag to store these in after

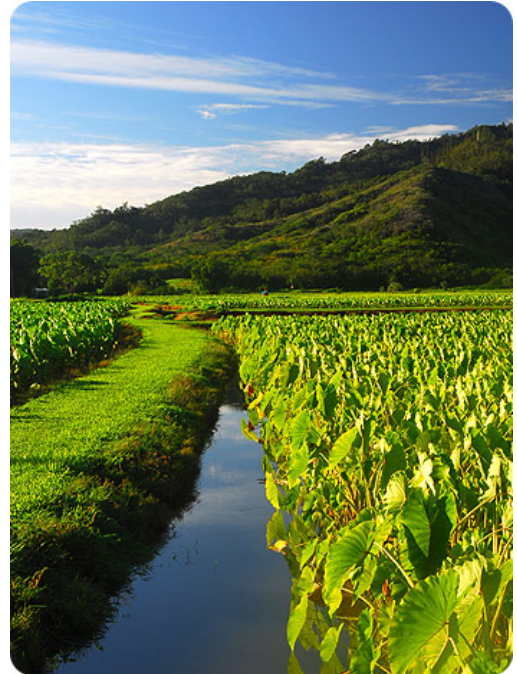
_____ Hat or visor and sunscreen
